Scripture

St. John 15:14-17

¹⁴ You are My friends if you do whatever I command you.

¹⁵ No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.

¹⁶ You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and *that* your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.

¹⁷ These things I command you, that you love one another.

Prophetic Note

- For those that are truly in love with God, there is no comprehension of what God will do for them
- Revelation has to supersede what we feel about situations...it is the only way to stay in love with God!
- We must come to the realization that we are in a life-changing moment, a moment that leads on to perfection, unlimited possibilities – overwhelming us with His grace! (Romans 12: 2)
- We must be wise and learn how to wisely sort out heavenly wisdom...aligning the Word with the applicable situations
- We heed to heavenly wisdom – that the moment we are experiencing will extend to future generations!
- Deuteronomy 8: 8-15

Point of Application

1. Moments like these are only initiated and orchestrated by the Father!
2. We must willfully and joyfully prepare a place to meet with the Father God when He dictates that we need to do so!
3. We have to cooperate with the counsel of the Father – He makes us into more than we can ever think or ask!
4. Envision, plan and strategize purposely to strengthen all the families of the earth with the gift that you have been entrusted with, and are a steward over!
5. Walk humble enough to be qualified to move into the seasons and times of overwhelming from God!
6. Release God and those assigned to make everything new when God decides to make everything new in our lives!
7. Know when and how to change postures!

- a. Serving with servants or walking with kings!
8. We must always strive to have our being in Jesus Christ – in Him alone are limitless possibilities and the favor of God. He always chooses to do more when we live in Him!

Prophetic Note

- Ensure that the filters we use with the Word do not box in God...when the gift brings us before great men who are our enemies (Numbers 13), our assignment is to bring the great men down!
- Only knowing that you have been chosen for so much more is going to enable you to bring down these great men!
- This generation will not be intimidated!
- Our God is the GREATEST!
